

## 6 Hour Collaged Floral Bouquet

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*A number of the fabrics needed for this quilt will be chosen **after** you have created your original bouquet. Waiting to make your fabric selections will save you time and money! I will be available to help you in your choices. I will bring floral fabrics that you can “pick a few blossoms” from. You will not actually sew borders on during class, but if you bring your choices to class with you, I can help you choose the best candidates! **You can bring your sewing machine if you work fast, but you will probably not use it in class.***

### Supply List:

1. 3 yards Pellon® “Shir-tailor®” fusible interfacing (buy only this product!)
2. Portable ironing surface and iron; pins, machine needles, etc.
3. A #2 pencil and sharpener
4. Fray-Check® - at least one full bottle
5. 1 yard pre-washed muslin (to use as pressing cloth)
6. Scissors for fabric cutting
7. Scissors for all other cutting
8. 25” X 25” piece of clear vinyl (5 or 8mm thick)
9. Rotary mat, cutter and ruler
10. 6 – 8 pieces pre-washed floral fabric for blossoms – fat quarters may work – open fabric and see how many whole flowers are available. With some prints a long ¼ yard might be the better choice. Look for Benartex’s “Flower Show I & II.” *Bring every (within reason!) large flower in your stash – old and new.*
  - Look for flowers that are 2 – 5 inches square. Very large flowers (larger than 6” square) may not be as successful. Don’t forget that you need a few smaller flowers to “fill in” between large flowers.
  - Bring both “realistic” and “stylized” flowers
  - Bring flowers in a variety of size, color and value, just as you would for any quilting project.
  - Bring flowers that are clearly defined – where there is space between one blossom and another.
  - Bring fabrics that also have buds and leaves.
11. Scrap of fabric for vase – (usually not a color in your flowers and not essential to bring as your bouquet will determine the style and color of this vase)
12. ¾ yard printed fabric for central background – **this fabric will be chosen after you have created your bouquet.**
