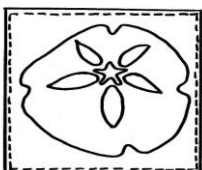
## ***Quilt Show Demonstrations***

Here's her recipe:

1 c. (2 cubes) butter or margarine  
4 oz. Baker's unsweetened chocolate  
4 eggs  
2 c. sugar

1 t. peppermint or vanilla  
1 c. flour  
1 c. nuts (optional)

Melt butter or margarine and chocolate together in microwave safe bowl. Stir in eggs, sugar and peppermint or vanilla flavoring. Stir in flour and nuts. Pour into greased 9 x 13 pan and bake for 25 – 30 minutes at 350 degrees. Cool in pan.

Cream together:

4 T. butter or margarine  
2 T. milk

2 c. powdered sugar  
2 t. peppermint or vanilla

Frost brownies then chill until firm.

Melt together:

2 oz. semi-sweet chocolate chips

2 T. butter or margarine

Spread over frosted brownies and chill until firm.
